Public Hearing for Interim Use Permit
November 29th, 2018

Chairperson, Robert Brewster, read a letter of support written from one resident responding.


Chairperson, Robert Brewster, opened the Public Comment Portion of the meeting and read the meeting rules for which the public shall follow.

Discussed the number of primitive campsites, well samples that need testing from Dept. of Health, length of stays by any group or family, high impact events, Vacation Home Rental Permit from State of MN. and regulating well water and septic flow issues with rental cabins. Much information will be taken from previous approved permit that will expire on January 14th, 2019.
