Public Hearing on a Interim Use Permit

June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021

The Ogema Township Planning Commission held a Public Hearing on Friday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Ogema Town Hall for Patrick and Mary Kester's Interim Use Permit. The following were present: Zoning Administrator, Robert Brewster, Planning Commission members, Carol King and James Klatt, and Clerk, Robert Sunstrom. Also present were Patrick Kester, Mary Kester, Nicolas Kester, John Honsa and Anne Haas.

Zoning Administrator, called the hearing to order. (Meeting to be tape recorded.)

Zoning Administrator, will oversee the hearing.

Zoning Administrator, read the Public Hearing Notice published in Hinckley News. Same notice went on posted notice at town hall and sent to 17 residents within a quarter mile with 7 duplicate letters, so 12 total.

Zoning Administrator, gave an overview of the Public Hearing.

Zoning Administrator, read the meeting rules for which the public shall follow.

Zoning Administrator, read letter of written testimony by Kurt Kiffmeyer, stating there isn't any objection to manufacturing of dock systems with noise or traffic. Supports Custom Portable docks.

John Honsa, residing at 44683 Tamarack River Road, basically said the same and he supports local residents wanting to bring job growth to township.

Planning Commission and Applicants discussed and asked questions to each other regarding issues concerning this permit.
