Public Hearing on a Variance September 30th, 2021

The Ogema Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing on Thursday, September 30th, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Ogema Town Hall. The following were present: Charles Kramer, Anne Haas and Clerk, Robert Sunstrom. Ronald Meehan was absent. Also present were Jay Lusso and Michael Smith.

He states that according to Ordinance 2020-1, he cannot build an accessory structure on this property because of the 100' setback rule. Board of Appeals asked questions to Jay Lusso and Michael Smith about said property.

The Board of Appeals made these assumptions in their Finding of Facts.

- Michael Smith is the owner of parcel # 23.5091.000 in Ogema Township, Pine, County, MN. In the Open Space Area.
- 2. The construction of a Accessory Structure is disallowed on the parcel because the structure is less than 100' from center line of road at the building line. (Ord. Section 13,a,1).
- 3. An application for a variance was received from Michael Smith on 9-09-21 at Town Board meeting.
- 4. Notice of Public Hearing was published on 9-16-21 in the Hinckley News and posted on the Town Hall notice board on 9-13 -21.
- 5. The Ogema Township Board of Appeals conducted a Public Hearing to consider the Variance on 9-30-21.
- 6. In Ordinance 2020-1 Section 20,b, under Limitations 1-7, by an unanimous vote of 2-0 with one supervisor absent, these findings were satisfied in each category.

On a motion made by Anne Haas and second by Charles Kramer, meeting was adjourned at 9:20 a.m. Motion carried. Both voting, yes.
