Chairperson, Raymond Thieling, opened the Public Comment Portion of the meeting and read the meeting rules for which the public shall follow.



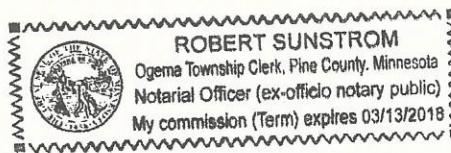
Chairperson, Raymond Thieling, closed the Public Comment Portion of Hearing.




On a motion made by Ronald Meehan and second by Raymond Thieling, meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m. Motion carried. Both voting, yes.
